Dues are \$15 for full membership or \$10 for associate membership.

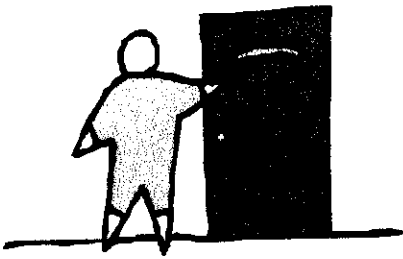
